Two years ago Minister for Education Norma Foley announced funding to provide free schoolbooks to all Primary school children.

Although at a reduced rate this year, again, funding is being provided directly to primary schools to provide schoolbooks, workbooks and copybooks to all children at the beginning of the school year.

All schoolbooks will remain the property of the school and will be provided on loan to children for the duration of the 2025/2026 school year. They must be returned to school at the end of the school year to hopefully be reused in future years. Parents are requested to remind their children to take care of their books and keep them in good condition during the year. For Senior classes, it is not permitted to write on textbooks.

There are some related classroom resources that are not covered by the scheme. A list of additional items parents will need to supply for the return to school in September 2025 is included below.
